

PATIENT REGISTRATION

Patients arriving for inpatient or out-patient services will first stop at the patient registration desk. Patients needing to preregister for outpatient services can do so easily by calling 263-6660.

VISITING HOURS

Memorial Hospital encourages family members to be involved in the patient's plan of care. Regular visiting hours are 11:00 a.m. to 8:30 p.m. each day; however, family members may visit at any time.

Children ages seven through twelve years are allowed with adult supervision.

Children six and under are permitted in the family-centered childbirth unit if they are members of the immediate family of the new mother and baby. Younger children are also allowed to visit a terminally ill patient.

HOSPITAL SERVICES

Memorial Hospital's location on NE 10th Street provides easy access with ample parking. The Emergency Entrance is located on the south side of the building accessed by Memorial View.

Emergency Services

A team of Advanced Practice Providers cover Memorial's 24-hour Emergency Department in collaboration with physicians. Registered nurses who have advanced training in life support and trauma care provide emergency nursing care.

Birthing Center

Memorial's family-centered childbirth unit offers many amenities including epidural services, childbirth education classes, candlelight dinner, and the Baby Basket program. Private rooms offer a peaceful setting for highly individualized care.

Skilled Care

Memorial Hospital offers skilled care for patients who may require a transition from acute care to non-acute services. (Skilled nursing care is also available at Village Manor senior care facility and through Home Health and Hospice of Dickinson County, Memorial Health System affiliates).

Laboratory

The hospital supports a modern diagnostic lab. State-of-the-art equipment enables a large number of automated tests to be run with a short response time.

Radiology

A full range of diagnostic imaging services including x-ray, 3D mammography, CT, MRI, ultrasound, non-invasive ultrasound, nuclear medicine, bone density, and fluoroscopy.

Rehabilitation Services

Physical therapy, occupational therapy, speech therapy and sports medicine services are provided through Memorial Health System Rehabilitation & Sports Medicine. Evalua-

tions and appropriate treatment programs are designed to restore patients to their highest level of functioning.

Respiratory Care

Cardiopulmonary services include diagnostic testing, therapeutic procedures and patient and family education.

ROSE Unit

This geriatric behavioral health unit is renowned throughout the area for providing quality care in servicing the unique needs of the elderly population. Patients are referred by physicians, care facilities, mental health centers, psychologists, agencies serving the elderly, or the individual's family.
