- **Certified Nursing Assistant** – Under the direction of a charge nurse, you will be responsible for helping the resident(s) with their activities of daily living including but not limited to; bathing, toileting, dressing, feeding, oral hygiene, etc.

The ideal Medication Aide will be extremely detail-oriented, have excellent communication and interpersonal skills, and possess in-depth knowledge of resident care procedures.
